VASHTI: Banish me if that makes you happy. But I'll get you my pretty, and your little dog too!

KING: (Weirded out) What?

VASHTI: I meant, you haven't seen the last of me!

GUARDS move to take VASHTI off-stage, but she pulls away from their grasp and walks offstage with great dignity.

MINISTER 2: Excellent move, your highness!

KING: Yeah, but now I need a *new* queen! (*Sighs*) If only I had a wife ... I mean, a better wife than the *last* one ... whatever her name was ...

KING

I would while away the hours Enjoying all my powers Feel happy with my life 'Cause it's great being ruler But I know I could be cooler If I only had a wife

We would be a happy pairing With everybody staring Looking sharper than a knife If the peasants get all restless Then my guards will beat them senseless If I only had a wife

Oh she would surely be My sweetheart close at hand Obeying every order I command I always get What I demand

Just as long as she obeys me

If I only had a wife

KING: Someone find me a wife!

MINISTERS run off. MINISTER 3 quickly returns with ESTHER in tow.

MINISTER 3: Found one! She was wandering around the castle with a tour group.

KING: Where are you from, honey?

ESTHER: Kansas.

KING: Well, you aren't in Kansas anymore, Toto. Are you married?

ESTHER: Am I what?!

KING: Okay, that's a good sign. What do you know about feminism, women's liberation, DEI initiatives ... that kind of thing?

ESTHER: I don't think any of that has been invented yet.

KING: Perfect! You're hired!

ESTHER: Hired for what?

KING: Queen!

ESTHER: Don't you mean 'married,' not 'hired?'

KING: Sure whatever. Welcome to your new life!

MINISTER places a crown on ESTHER's head.
